Trading Standards are warning organisations to look out for an email purporting to be from the HSE.

The email states that the Health and Safety Executive have received a complaint about your organisation regarding possible violations during the lockdown period. There is an Excel spreadsheet attached which they state contains details of the complaint – **DO NOT OPEN** this attachment. We have had confirmation from the HSE that this is a SCAM

Remember Take Five:

Stop -Taking a moment to stop and think before parting with your money or information could keep you safe.

Challenge -Could it be fake? It's ok to reject, refuse or ignore any requests. Only criminals will try to rush or panic you.

Protect - Contact your bank immediately if you think you've fallen for a scam and report it to Action Fraud.
